STEPS TO BOOKING A DJ

Provide our agents with your event information - Our agents will go over your needs, event specifics, and collect all of the information and place it into your booking in our system.

Pick your DJ - Unless you already know whom you want to meet, our agents will provide a list of DJs that best match your needs based on your criteria and availability.

Set up a complimentary consultation - Consultations can be held over Zoom, Skype, or phone call, and we make sure the DJ is the right fit for you before any paperwork is signed.

IF ALL GOES WELL

Our agents send and collect the following

CONTRACT

Our agents will send a basic agreement to bind the booking.

DEPOSIT INVOICE

Our agents will send a 50% deposit invoice to confirm the booking.

FORMS OF PAYMENT

We accept cash, check, money orders, or cashier's checks. Paypal and credit cards on approval only are subject to a 5% surcharge.

CONFIRMATION EMAIL

After the contract and deposit are in place you will receive a confirmation email.

CUSTOM MUSIC REQUESTS

Our agents will get in contact with you two months prior to your wedding date to collect your music requests to place into the entertainment itinerary.

VENDOR REQUESTS

Our agents will get in touch with you a week before the wedding to collect all vendors' contact

SGM Events can provide an insurance certificate for the venue.

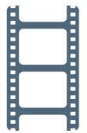

NO CANCELLATIONS OF CONTRACTS

We will not cancel a contract on you once bound even if the DJ gets a higher offer, we stick to our word.

FORCE MAJEURE* / REPLACEMENTS

Our agents will get in touch with you a week before the wedding to collect all vendors' contact information. If the DJ cannot make it due to a circumstance out of his control (hospital, death, or an unforeseen accident) we can provide a replacement.

*Force Majeure is a common clause in contracts that essentially frees both parties from liability or obligation when an extraordinary event or circumstance beyond the control of the parties, such as a war, strike, riot, crime, or an event described by the legal term act of God (such as a hurricane, flooding, earthquake, volcanic eruption, etc.), prevents one or both parties from fulfilling their obligations under the contract.
